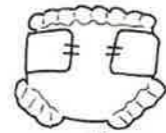
Kitchen waste

Safety hypodermic needles and other waste from home healthcare

This waste will be incinerated for sanitary purposes. Please place the waste inside PET plastic bottles, milk cartons, or similar items, mark as "Dangerous," and put them out with the burnable waste.

Non-burnable waste Fee applies

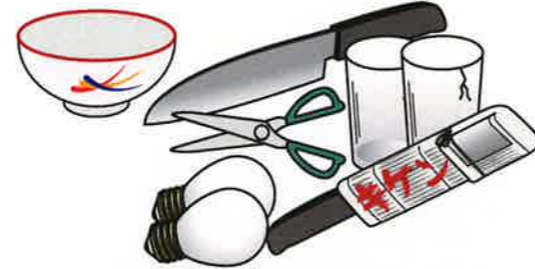
City-designated yellow bags



Leather and rubber products



Plastics



Sharp instruments, glass, ceramics, and light bulbs

Please wrap these in newspaper or similar materials, place them in the designated waste bags, and mark as "Dangerous,"

Plastic containers and packaging Fee applies

City-designated translucent white bags



Containers marked with the plastics recycling logo
*Empty the containers of all contents, clean them, and place them in the designated bags.



Dispose of PET plastic bottles as type-4 recyclables



Bubble wrap



Medicine container

Disposable planters



Convenience store bento boxes

Type-4 recyclables Free of charge

Rinse containers before disposal. (If they cannot be cleaned, dispose of as burnable waste.)

Styrofoam trays and other items without the plastic recycling logo

Bottles used for beverages, condiments, etc.

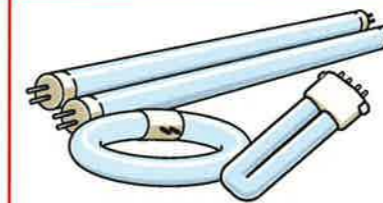
Harmful waste Free of charge

Transparent and translucent bags

Do not place these in (yellow) bags for non-burnable waste. Doing so could lead to the risk of fire. Use a marker or other writing instrument to clearly indicate "Harmful waste" on the bag.



Rechargeable batteries
Non-rechargeable batteries and thermometers containing mercury



Fluorescent lamps
Please place these inside boxes or other containers to prevent breakage, since they contain dangerous toxic mercury. *Dispose of incandescent light bulbs as non-burnable waste



Spray cans, gas cartridges for portable stoves, gas lighters
Dispose of these without puncturing them, since doing so could be dangerous.



Metal items more than 3 mm thick (hammers, pliers, etc.)

Used small appliances Free of charge

Place these in the collection boxes installed at community centers, welfare centers, the East City Office, or the Lake Shikotsu City Office.

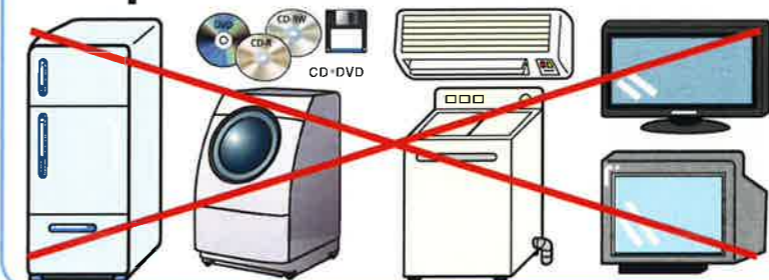

Oversized waste Fee applies

(Collected door-to-door for a fee as requested by telephone)
Waste that cannot be placed in the designated waste bags qualify as oversized waste.
First purchase an oversize waste collection sticker (300 yen each).

Items that cannot be collected or accepted by the city

- * Items subject to the Act on Recycling of Specified Kinds of Home Appliances (CRT tubes, LCD screens, plasma TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers)
- * CRT computer displays
- * Propane canisters, fireproof safes, waste tires, car batteries, fluids
- * Fire extinguishers, motorcycles, garden stones/earth/rocks (these do not qualify as waste)
- * Items more than 2 m long or more than 100 kg in weight.
