"Yami baito" are jobs that criminal groups advertise on social media, such as X and Facebook, that involve fraud, robbery or other criminal activities.

What kind of recruitment posts are used?



Key phrases such as "high paying", "easy", "all you have to do is receive a parcel", "you just open a bank account and sign a phone contract", "it's not a crime", "everyone's doing it!" are commonly used



What will happen if you do a "yami baito"?

You will be guilty of committing fraud/robbery.

You will be threatened into continuing if you try to quit.

You will be arrested without exception.



There is no such thing as an easy,
high paying part-time job.

Both Japanese and foreign nationals have been involved in "yami baito". Don't be lured in by jobs that sound too good to be true, and live a safe and healthy life in Japan.
